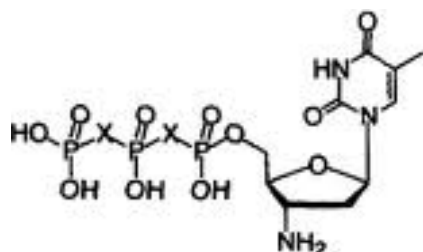


Description: AZT is a widely used antiviral agent. AZT penetrates the cell membrane and is converted into AZT triphosphate which inhibits the reaction of reverse transcription. AZT triphosphate (3'-Azido-3'-Deoxythymidine 5'-Triphosphate) can be used for inhibition of reverse transcription in vitro and for the investigation of polymerase-substrate interactions.

Applications: AZT triphosphate is used for inhibition of reverse transcription, telomerase activity and thymidine phosphorylation. It is a suppressor for HIV-type 1 replication. AZT triphosphate can also be used for removal of iron from transferrin.



Concentration: 100 mM, solution in water
MW = 505 g/mol for free acid
